

Houston teen 'Comes Home' a winner from 2017 IMC Awards in Hollywood

HOLLYWOOD, California — Independent singers and bands from around the world gathered for the 2017 Indie Music Channel (IMC) Awards in Hollywood, and among them was 14-year-old Brooke Michelle, an eighth-grade honor student at St. [REDACTED] Catholic School.
